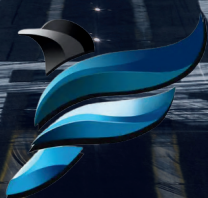

"Do I need Science to become a pilot?"

Short answer: Yes. You need Physics and Mathematics at the 10+2 level. Didn't have them? Don't panic—you can complete them through approved open schooling pathways.



"Is pilot training expensive?"

Yes, it's an investment. But so is becoming a doctor, engineer, or lawyer. The difference? Your classroom is 10,000 feet in the air.



"Can I become a pilot if I wear glasses?"

Most likely, yes.

Many pilots wear corrective lenses. What matters is meeting the required aviation medical standards.



"How many hours do I need before becoming a commercial pilot?"

Requirements vary by country and licensing authority, but most professional pathways require approximately 200+ flight hours before CPL eligibility.



"Will I fly on Day 1?"

Not immediately.

First, you'll learn safety procedures, aircraft basics, and operational knowledge. Then comes the fun part—taking the controls.



"How long does it take to become a pilot?"

Most students complete their flight training within 12–24 months, depending on weather, training frequency, licensing requirements, and individual progress.



"What happens after I get my CPL?"

You'll build experience, earn additional ratings if required, and work toward airline opportunities, charter operations, corporate aviation, cargo flying, or flight instruction.
